Standard terms of deputation of officers
deputed to various corporations/public
undertakings.

The undersigned is directed to say that all the Departments of Government have been requested in Finance Department memo No.40169(40)/F dated.22.10.83 with a copy of the standard terms of deputation to adopt the same for sanctioning the terms and conditions of deputation of officers deputed to various Corporations/ Public Undertakings.

It has been decided that the followings may be added to the above standard terms of deputation in a separate para in order to facilitate the drawal as well as recovery of long term advances in favour of the Government servants on deputation to various Corporations/ Public Undertakings.

"The foreign employer may grant advances to Sri for building a house or to purchase a motor car/scooter or moped etc. from their own source and the recovery shall be made from his monthly pay bill by the foreign employer. If any principal or interest remains outstanding at the time of repatriation of the Government servant from foreign employment to his parent organisation, such outstanding dues shall be recovered from the concerned Government servants pay and allowances, leave salary etc. by the concerned D.D.O. through issue of a Misc Money receipt and be remitted to the foreign employer indicating the particulars of recovery effect. All such informations may be recorded in the L.P.C. of the concerned Government servant as well in Service Book of concerned Government servant at the time of his repatriation."
