Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of Governor, under rule 212(b) of the Orissa Service Code, to the deputation of Shri..... a member of the O.A.S. Class-I (J.B.)/O.A.S. Class-II for appointment as of the said..... for a period of year with effect from the date of relief i.e. or till the date of rejoining under Government which ever is earlier, on the following Foreign Service terms and conditions.

2. The period of absence on deputation will be treated as on foreign service.

3. During the period of deputation Shri..... will have the option either to get his pay fixed in the deputation post under the rules and orders of the State Government or draw his grade pay in the scale of Rs..... plus a deputation allowance @ 20% of his grade pay subject to a maximum of Rs.250/- per month and subject to the overall limit prescribed in Rule 228(2) of the Orissa Service Code.

4. Shri..... will be entitled to Dearness allowance under the rules of the parent Govt. or under the rules of the foreign employer according as he retains the scale of pay under the parent Government or he draws pay in the scale attached to the post under the foreign employer.

5. He will be borne in the Cadre of C.A.S. Class-I (J.B.)/C.A.S. Class-II during the period of his deputation to the
6. The transit pay and T.A. for joining the post on deputation and for rejoining his post under Government on expiry of the term of deputation shall be borne by the
7. During period under deputation Shri..... will draw T.A. under rules of the foreign employer/State Government and the expenditure will be borne by the foreign employer.
8. During the period of deputation Shri..... will be governed by the leave and pension rules of the parent Government.
9. During the period of deputation Shri..... may receive house rent allowance from the foreign employer in accordance with Finance Department Memo No.27670(96)/F., dated 21.8.63. In the event of the Foreign employer providing him a house hired by them, rent not exceeding 7½% of his pay should be realised from him.
10. He shall be entitled to the medical facilities as admissible to him under the rules of parent Government. *F.D.M. No. 48199(40) Dt 7-12-84*
11. The Foreign employer shall bear the leave salary and pension contribution in respect of the officer-deputation as per provisions in the Orissa Service Code and as per the rates prescribed in Appendix-9 of the Orissa Service Code. *Ask for option to avail Medical facilities as mentioned in Govt./Foreign Govt.*
- The Foreign employer shall pay these contributions as per the monthly rates mentioned below:

- (i) Pension contribution Rs. per month.
- (ii) Leave salary contribution Rs. per month.

The particulars of payment of these contributions as and when made by the foreign employer, shall be reported by the later to the A.G.Orissa under intimation to this Department.

12. In case the foreign service contributions are found at the end of a particular year, wholly or partially unpaid and the balance outstanding is more than a months due and it is not paid within the fifteen days from the close of the year, interest will accrue on the entire outstanding amount at the rate of 4 paise for Rs.100/- a day for the period from the date of expiry of the said grace period of fifteen days till the date on which the amount due at the end of the year is finally paid.

13. The Foreign Employer shall be liable to bear Dearness Allowance on leave salary in respect of leave taken by the Officer during the period of his deputation or on termination thereof.

14. The Foreign Employer shall also be liable to pay leave salary in respect of any disability incurred in and through foreign service even though such disability manifests just after termination of foreign service.

15. Shri..... shall not be entitled to any other remuneration or concession of pecuniary value unless it is specified in the terms of his deputation with specific sanction of Government.

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
