Sub :- Grant of rent free accommodation.

The undersigned is directed to say that the question of laying down a well-defined principle in the matter of grant of rent free accommodation to certain Government servants was under the consideration of Government for some time past. After careful consideration of the matter it has been decided that the following category of Officers may be allowed rent-free accommodation:-

- (a) Officers and subordinates required to live in a specified locality or building who, because of the nature of their duties, are, with some regularity, called on duty, at any time in the 24 hours.
- (b) Officials, who, in addition to the regular duties have to exercise direct supervision over resident students and have accordingly to live in close proximity to the hostel.
- (c) Officers whose pay is fixed on the ground that free accommodation (or an allowance) is provided and who are required to live at or near their work e.g. caretaker of the Council House.
