Sub:- Sanction of Advance Increments to State
Government Servants for acquiring Post-Graduate
qualification.

...

In Para-2(a) of the Finance Department Office Memorandum No. CS-I-65/78-2339/F., dated 15.1.79 it has been stipulated that acquisition of MS/MD Degree will not be considered as a substantial higher qualification to merit advance increments by the State Government servants. This was reconsidered by Government only in respect of Medical Officers in Class-II of the State service working in periphery where services of higher qualified Medical Officers are considered essential.

It has, therefore, been decided that in Modification of the stipulation made in Para-2(a) of Finance Department Office Memorandum No. 2339/F., dated, dated 15.1.79 referred to above, the Medical Officers in the periphery in Class-II of the State Government service who possess P.G. qualification (Except D.F.M.) will be entitled to two advance increments from the date of award of such degree or date of joining in service after completion of the course whichever is later. The pay of the concerned Doctors will be regulated by adding 2 increments notionally to the pay which they were drawing on the date of acquisition of the Post-Graduate qualification or the date of joining after acquiring such qualification whichever is later, as the case may be.

The financial benefit on this account will be available from the date of issue of this Office Memorandum and no arrear financial benefit will be given for the past period. The other conditions for sanction of advance increments stipulated in the above mentioned Finance Department Office Memorandum No. 2339/F., dated 15.1.79 will also be applicable for sanction of advance increments to Medical Officers in the periphery as stated above.
