Sub:- Delegation of powers to sanction Motor Car Advance in favour of Individual Government Servants.

In pursuance to F.D. O.M No-11217/F., dtd. 06.03.1981, the powers were delegated to sanction Motor Cycle/Scooter advance in respect of eligible individual Government servants working under different Heads of Department and Administrative Departments of Government. But, the advance to Government servants for purchase of Motor Car is sanctioned by Finance Department in terms of Rule-253 of the Odisha General Financial Rules.

Now, for decentralisation of such financial powers, Government have been pleased to decide that, powers for sanction of Motor Car advance in case of eligible individual Government servants shall be delegated to the different Departments of Government.

Sanction of advances in individual cases shall be subject to the eligibility criteria, the prescribed monetary ceiling and regulated by the existing rules and instructions issued by the Finance Department and amended from time to time.

Budget provision of Motor Car Advance shall be appropriated and communicated by the Finance Department to all the Administrative Departments of Government as per their requisitions.

This shall come into force with effect from **01.04.2015**.
