Sanction of Motor Cycle Advance to Government servants who are on deputation to Foreign Service.

The undersigned is directed to say that with issue of the Finance Department Office Memorandum No. 4635/F dated 9.9.80 pertaining to delegation of Powers for sanction of Motor Cycle Advance in favour of Government servants, in certain quarters, doubt has been expressed as to who shall accord formal sanction of Government for enabling the foreign employer's to sanction such advance in favour of a Government servant serving under him (foreign employer) on deputation.

It is hereby clarified that the powers for sanction of such advance, being already delegated by the Finance Department it is now the concerned administrative departments who will accord such formal sanction under Rule 251 of the O.G.F.R. Volume-I in case of government servants serving under a foreign employer on deputation. Basing upon that the foreign employer will however sanction the advance out of his own fund.
