Bhubaneswar, the 31st July, 1995.

Sub:-

Payment of cash equivalent of leave salary to Govt. Servants who retire on the ground of invalidation.

In terms of Para(f) of the Finance Department O.M.No.2281/F., dt.12.1.81, a Government servant who is retired on the ground of invalidation is required to apply for cash equivalent of unutilised leave salary before the date of such retirement.

2. The above provision has been reviewed in the light of the decision made by Government of India and after careful consideration, Govt. have been pleased to decide that the leave encashment benefit may be granted suo motu by the competent authority in cases of death while in service, retirement on superannuation, voluntary retirement and retirement on ground of invalidation without waiting for any application in this regard subject to the provisions contained in Finance Department O.M. No.46545/F., dt.17.12.91.

3. The above decision shall come into force from the date of issue of this order. The cases pending with the authority will be decided in terms of this order.

4. Necessary amendment to the Orissa Leave Rules, 66 will be made in due course.
