Subject:- Payment of cash equivalent of leave salary to Government Servants on voluntary/Pre-mature retirement.

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In terms of para 2(b) of the Finance Department Office Memorandum No. 2281/F., dated 12.1.81, the leave, in respect of which cash payment is made to a Government servant in case of voluntary/ Pre-mature retirement or retirement on invalidation, should not extend beyond his normal date of retirement on superannuation.

2. The matter has been reconsidered in the light of decisions made recently by Government of India and the Governor has now been pleased to decide that encashment of Earned Leave due and admissible, subject to a maximum of 180 days may be allowed in cases of pre-mature/voluntary retirement or retirement on invalidation, even if this exceeds the period between the date on which the officer retires and the date on which he would have retired in the normal course on superannuation. 2/10

3. This order takes effect from the date of issue, and cases pending may be regulated as per the above decision. Cases already decided will, however, not be ~~re-ex~~ reopened.
