Sub:- Adminissibility of cash equivalent of Earned Leave -
clarification regarding.

In terms of para 4(b) (iv) of Finance Department Office Memorandum No.55423/F., dtd.14.11.1986, a Government Servant is entitled to cash equivalent of unutilised Earned Leave subject to a maximum of 240 days in the event of termination of re-employment after retirement. A question has been raised whether a re-employed person will be entitled to cash equivalent of unutilised Earned Leave available to him during the period of re-employment in addition to cash equivalent of unutilised earned leave already allowed on the date of superannuation.

2. After careful consideration, Government have been pleased to decide that a Government Servant who is re-employed after retirement may, on termination of his re-employment be granted cash equivalent in respect of earned leave at his credit on the date of termination of re-employment subject to a maximum of 240 days, including the period for which encashment was allowed at the time of retirement.

3. Necessary amendment to the O.L.R.-66 will be issued in due course.
