Bhubaneswar, the 28th February 2025

No.FIN-BUD6-SFC-0008/2025 / 6840/F., In exercise of the powers conferred by section 11 of the Odisha Finance Commission (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 1993 (Odisha Act 28 of 1993), the State Government do hereby determine the following fees, honorarium and allowances payable to the Chairman, Members and Member-Secretary of the Sixth State Finance Commission, namely: -

1. Honorarium :
 - a. The Chairman shall be paid a consolidated honorarium of rupees one lakh seventy-five thousand per month.
 - b. The Members other than Member-Secretary shall be paid a consolidated honorarium of rupees one lakh per month.
 - c. The Member-Secretary shall be paid the pay, allowances and other service benefits as applicable to his grade under the relevant rules.
2. Travelling Allowance :
 - a. The Chairman shall be paid Travelling Allowance, Daily Allowance and entitlement for journey on tour as admissible to Chief Secretary while touring on duty on official business.
 - b. The Members other than the Member Secretary shall be paid Travelling Allowance, Daily Allowance and entitlement for journey on tour as admissible Commissioner-cum-Secretary while touring on duty on official business.
 - c. The Member-Secretary shall be paid Travelling Allowance, Daily Allowance and entitlement for journey on tour as applicable to his grade under the relevant rules.
 - d. Travel from workplace to Bhubaneswar for Finance Commission related work shall be treated as duty on official business and shall be considered for journey tickets.
 - e. For tour inside and outside of the State on official business, no prior permission from Government shall be required.

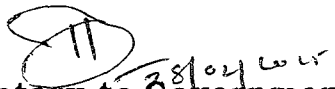

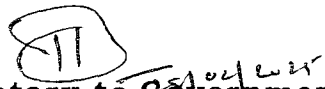

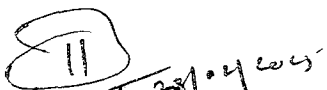
