Grant of an advance of ₹15,71,80,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Crore Seventy-One Lakh Eighty Thousand) only from the Odisha Contingency Fund for Advance required to comply the order date 03.04.2025 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in CIVIL APPEAL NO.4769 OF 2025 [Arising out of SLP(C) No.3862/2018] and order dated 15.10.2025 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Odisha in EXFA No.1/2017 towards deposit of the balance amount of **Rs.15,71,80,000/-** (Rupees Fifteen Crore Seventy-One Lakh Eighty Thousand only) of the decretal amount of the valuation of the land as per the rate determined by the Arbitrator Justice Patra, with the registry of the High Court during the pendency of the First Appeal.

ORDER: SANCTIONED

2. The advance is debitable to the Head of Account:

"8000- Contingency Fund-00-201-Appropriation from the Consolidated Fund-1648-Contingency Fund - 92001-Advance from Contingency Fund."

For expenditure under the Head of Account:-

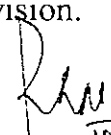
