No. 41030—CCA-10/87-F.—In exercise of powers conferred by the provise to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa hereby makes the following Rules for regulating the method of recruitment and the conditions of service of persons appointed to the Orissa Service of Auditors. namely:—

Short title and commencemont,

- 1. (I) These Rules may be called the Orissa Service of Auditors (Audit Officers) Rules, 1987
  - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Orissa Gazette.

Definition

- 2. In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires—
  - (a) "Commission" means the Orissa Public Service Commission,
  - (b) "Department" means a Department of the Secretariat as prescribed in the Rules of Business framed under clause (3) of Article 166 of the Constitution of India.
  - (c) "Government" means the Government of Orissa.
  - (d) "Secretary" means the Secretary of the Finance Department.
  - (e) "Service" means the Orissa Service of Auditors.
