OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Cash payment in lieu of unutilised
Earned Leave on the date of retirement.

....

The undersigned is directed to refer to para 3 (d) of Finance Department Office Memorandum No. C. S. II 54/77-60319(F), dated 28th November, 1977, according to which, from the cash amount worked out as laid down in para 3(c) *ibid*, the pension and pensionary equivalent of other retirement benefits are to be deducted. A doubt has arisen, whether the 'temporary increase in pension' payable from time to time along with the pension should also be deducted from the cash amount worked out *vide* para 3(c) *ibid*. It is hereby clarified that the 'temporary increase in pension' is also deductible along with the pension and pensionary equivalent of other retirement benefits from the cash payment worked out *vide* para 3(c) *ibid*.

2. This order would also take effect from 30th November, 1977. In cases where the 'temporary increase in pension' has not been deducted the Disbursing Officers are to stop the payment of such 'temporary increase in pension' so long as the overpayment made, if any, is adjusted.
