OFFICE MEMORANDUM

The 31st May 1995

SUBJECT—Grant of Interim Relief to the State Government Employees.

Government have decided to grant Interim Relief of Rs. 100 per month to all State Government employees with effect from 1st April 1995.

2. The amount of Interim Relief will be *sui generis*, viz., it will neither be termed as 'Pay' nor 'Allowance' nor 'Wage'. Accordingly, this amount will not count for any service benefit, i. e., computation of House Rent Allowance, Dearness Allowance, Compensatory Allowance, Encashment of Leave, Pay Fixation, Pension or Gratuity, etc.

3. The Interim Relief sanctioned in Para. 1 above shall apply to the employees working under work-charged Establishments.

4. This shall not apply to the employees governed by U. G. C./AICTE scales of pay.

5. The Interim Relief so sanctioned shall be credited to the Provident Fund Account of the employees concerned.

6. The Interim Relief sanctioned in favour of the employees who have not yet been allotted with Provident Fund Account numbers and employees of work-charged establishments shall be drawn and deposited in Postal Time Deposits or any other Saving Certificate in the name of the person concerned.

RESOLUTION

The 24th July 1995

SUBJECT :—Revision of scales of pay under the Orissa Revised Scales of Pay Rules, 1989.

Government in Finance Department Resolution No. 36632, dated the 25th September 1989 and No. 23209/F., dated the 21st May 1992 have revised the scales of pay of non-gazetted Statistical posts of certain Department on par with analogous posts in the Directorate of Economics and Statistics.

The question of rationalising the pay scales of Statistical posts of some other Departments where qualification, procedure of recruitment, promotion and job contents are similar but existing in lower scales of pay was under consideration of Government for some time past. After careful consideration of Government in pursuance to rule 14 of the Orissa Revised Scales of Pay Rules 1989 have been pleased to decide that the pay and scales of these posts shall be revised as follows:—

Name of the Department (1)	Name of the post (2)	Existing scale (3)	Modified scale with designation (4)
Fisheries and Animal Resources.	Jr. Statistical Assistant.	1,350—2,200	1,400-2,300 (To be designated as Statistical Assistant.)
Health and Family Welfare.	Jr. Statistical Assistant.	1,355—2,200	1,400-2,300 (To be designated as Statistical Assistant.)
Industries	Jr. Statistical Assistant.	1,350—2,200	1,400-2,300 (To be designated as Statistical Assistant.)

The above revised scale as modified shall be effective from the 21st May 1992.

The incumbent may at his option retain his old pay until the date on which he has earned his next or any subsequent increment on the old scale or until he vacates his post or ceases to draw pay on that time scale as per rule 76 of the O. S. C. Such option shall be exercised within a period of two months from the date of publication of the resolution in the *Orissa Gazette*.
