R E S O L U T I O N

Bhubaneswar, the 7th June, 1982.

Sub : Surrender of earned leave in lieu of leave salary and allowances - clarification issued.

At present the benefit of surrender of E.L. for encashment by State Government employees is regulated under F.D. Resolution No. 25892/F., dated 24.5.78. In terms of this Resolution, a State Government employee who has either been suspended or removed/dismissed from Government service is not entitled to the benefit of encashment of leave from the date of such suspension or removal/dismissal. The benefit is also not admissible to a employee of State Government who could not avail of the benefit during any past block period due to delay on the part of sanctioning authority. Undue hardship is being caused on account of inadmissibility of the benefit in the above circumstances.

2. To remove these difficulties, Government, after careful consideration, have been pleased to decide that the employee suspended or removed/dismissed from service during the previous block period(s) on reinstatement in service in a subsequent block period may be allowed the benefit of encashment of leave in respect of the previous block period(s), if the period of suspension or removal/dismissal in service is treated as on duty subject to the condition that the authority sanctioning the benefit records a certificate that the Government servant in question could not avail of the benefit of surrender of leave during the previous block period(s) on account of suspension or removal/dismissal which period has been treated as on duty.

3. Government have also been pleased to decide that where an eligible employee could not get the benefit of surrender leave due only to administrative delays, he may be allowed the benefit for the expired block period within the course of 3 months of the commencement of the subsequent block period. Authority sanctioning Surrender of Leave in such cases shall record reasons for delay in the sanction order.

4. Payment of leave salary for the leave to be surrendered in the above cases shall be equivalent to the pay and allowances the employee was entitled to for the last but one (i.e. 23rd) month of the block period in respect of which the benefit of surrender of leave is granted subsequently.

5. This Resolution shall take effect from the current block period.

ORDER: Ordered that the Resolution be published in the next issue of the Orissa Gazette for general information and copies of the Resolution be forwarded to all concerned.


