- In all cases where the amount involved exceeds Rs:, 10,000/- against any particular individual pertaining to any one audit report of aided Middle English Schools, High Schools, Madrassas, Sanskrit Toils and Colleges.

Subject—Supply of Umbrella and Water-Bottle.

The undersigned is directed to say that providing Summer amenities, i. e. Umbrella and Water-bottle to the Drivers as well as to the Peons entrusted with distribution of Daks where morning office was functioning previously, was under consideration of the Government.

After careful consideration, Government have been pleased to decide that all the Drivers as well as the Peons entrusted with distribution of Daks are to be provided with an Umbrella within a monetary limit of Rs. 25 (including all taxes) and a Waterbottle within a monetary limit of Rs. 10 (including all taxes), each where the morning office was functioning previously.

Office subject to the terms and conditions and monetary limit as specified in Figure Department Office Memorand um No. 12124—Codes-58/86-F., dated the 12th March 1986.

Umbrellas/Water-bottles purchased within the above limit may be replaced after they are found completely useless but no Umbrella should be replaced unless it has been used for at least 4 years and Water-bottle at least for 2 years.

This order shall take effect from the date of issue.
