**Subject--Admissibility of Green Card incentive allowance during the period of leave surrendered for the benefit of encashment.**

In Finance Department Office Memorandum No. 26658-F., dated the 2nd June 1982, it was clarified that the allowances of compensatory nature as are allowed for specific purposes and paid during the period of duty or leave actually availed of, shall not be admissible in respect of leave surrendered for encashment. Doubts have been raised in certain quarters as to whether the incentive allowance granted in favour of a Government servant holding Green Card can be admissible in respect of leave surrendered by him for encashment.

2. It is further clarified that the incentive allowance granted in favour of the such Green Card holders being not compensatory in nature, can be admissible in respect of leave surrendered for encashment.

**Subject--Surrender of Earned Leave in lieu of leave salary and allowances—Withdrawal of the benefit**

In Finance Department Office Memorandum No. 34642-F., dated the 21st July 1973 read with Finance Department Resolution No. 25892-F., dated the 24th May 1978 the State Government introduced the above benefit in respect of the State Government employees. In course of time some additional benefits on this account have been extended to the police personnel, fire-service personnel, staff of the Guest House, Orissa Bhawan and Utkal Bhawan etc.

In the meantime Government have reviewed the position and after careful consideration of all aspects have decided that the benefit of surrender of Earned Leave in lieu of leave salary and allowances by the State Government employees shall stand withdrawn with effect from 1st April, 1993.
