Subject—Recovery of Bank dues.

I am directed to refer to this Department letter No. 8902(13)-F., dated the 9th March 1988 and to say that the recovery of bank loans advanced for various poverty amelioration programmes has not been encouraging. Timely recovery of bank loans is essential for re-cycling of fund to provide sustained lending support for various anti-poverty programmes.

Instructions were issued by the Chief Secretary to Government of Orissa in Finance Department letter No. 6561(13)-F.,

dated the 21st February 1987 for providing necessary support to the bank officials for ensuring timely recovery of bank dues. Instructions were also issued in Finance Department letter No. 8902(13)-F., dated the 9th March 1988 for extending co-operation to bank officials to ensure timely recovery of bank dues. Participation of Government Officials in recovery camps has no doubt improved the recovery position, but the need for continued participation by them, may not be over-emphasised. I would request you to follow instructions contained in the letters mentioned above and instruct all concerned to extend whole-hearted co-operation to the bank officials in holding recovery camps, contacting defaulters and also taking effective steps for recovery of bank dues. Officials like Subdivisional Officers, Tahasildars, Block Development Officers should be instructed to render all possible help to the bank officials in this regard to ensure better recovery performance in the days to come.
