The State Government in Finance Department Resolution No. CS-II-13/72-34642/F., dt. 21.7.73 as modified in Finance Department Resolution No. 25892/F., dt. 24.5.1978 have allowed its employees the benefit of surrender of earned leave for 30 days in lieu of leave salary and allowances once in a block period of 24 months commencing from 1st July, 1973 subject to other conditions specified therein.

2. On re-consideration, Governor has now been pleased to decide that the above concession shall be allowed once in a block period of 24 months commencing from 1st April instead of 1st July in order to make it conterminous with the financial year. In other words, the eighth block period of 1987-89 will cover the period from 1st April, 1987 to 31st March, 1989.

3. Government servants, who have not availed the benefit of the 1985-87 block period till the date of issue of this order, may be allowed to avail the same within 30.6.87 alongwith the grace period as admissible under rules.
