OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Bhubaneswar, the 27th January 1990

Subject—Determination of members of family of deceased subscribers to G. P. F.

The undersigned is directed to invite a reference to G. D. O. M. No. 40072-F., dated the 25th October 1988 on the subject mentioned above wherein it is clarified that the children born of a marriage which is null and void under Section 11 Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 the children gain a proprietary interest over the property of their parents if such property is their self acquisition.

In this context a doubt has arisen regarding the claims of the family members of the deceased subscribers belonging to Muslim community and Christian community.

It is clarified in Consultation with Law Department that under the Law governing

Christian community, illegitimate children have no right to succeed to the properties of their parents and the Law does not even recognize any children by adoption. But so far as Mohammedan Law is concerned, a group of Muslims are governed under the Hanafi Law of Inheritance and the other under the Shia Law of Inheritance. Those who are governed under the Hanafi Law of Inheritance, illegitimate child is considered to be the child of its mother only and as such, it inherits from its mother and its relations and they inherit from such child, whereas in case of those governed under the Shia Law of Inheritance, an illegitimate child does not inherit at all, not even from its mother or relations nor do they inherit from him.

Thus the pending cases if any may be settled accordingly.

The above clarification may be brought to the notice of all concerned for their guidance.

RESOLUTION

Subject—Anomalies in the Revised Scales of Pay, 1985

Consequent upon publication of the Orissa Revised Scales of Pay Rules, 1985, with effect from 1st January 1985, anomalies in the Revised Scales of pay of certain posts were brought to notice of Government in Finance Department. To consider such cases of anomalies and to make recommendations, Government in Finance Department Resolution No.60239-F., dated the 20th December 1986, constituted a High Power Committee under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government. The Committee considered all cases of anomalies received and gave its recommendations to Government.

After careful consideration of the recommendations given by the High Power Committee, Government in pursuance of Rule 16 of the Orissa Revised Scales of Pay Rules, 1985, have been pleased to decide that the revised scales of pay of the following posts notified in the first schedule to the said rules shall be amended to the extent as indicated below:—

The Orissa Revised Scales of Pay Rules, 1985, shall be deemed to have been amended with effect from 1-1-1985.

Formal notification for inclusion of these in the first schedule to the Orissa Revised Scales of Pay Rules, 1985, will be issued separately.
