Subject:- Leave benefits to the Non-Gazetted Policemen -
Extension thereof to the Police Personnel
considered equivalent to the rank of Inspector
of Police.

The question of extending the benefit of leave admissible to the Non-Gazetted Policemen including Non-Gazetted Fire Service Personnel in accordance with Finance Department Resolution No.6547/F., dated 11th February 1980 for working throughout the year on Sundays and Public Holidays and for putting extra hours of duty during working days, to the police personnel holding posts equivalent to the rank of Inspector of Police consequent upon conferment of Gazetted status on them has been under consideration of Government for some time past.

2. The above benefit of leave has since been extended to the Inspectors of Police in Finance Department Resolution No.3429/F., dated 29th July, 1982 after they were declared specially gazetted. Since the nature of duties performed by the following Police Personnel who have been declared specially gazetted have remained unaltered after conferment of gazetted status, the Governor has been pleased to decide that leave benefits as admissible to the Non-Gazetted Police Personnel as per the Resolution, dated 11th February 1980 referred to above will also be admissible to them to the extent these were available to them prior to conferment of the gazetted status.
