Sir,

Severe resource constraints have appeared in the current year which call for stringent measures to effect economy and reduce expenditure. Instructions have been issued from time to time to observe strict economy and austerity in non-plan expenditure. In order to tide over the difficulties, the State Government have decided to reduce by five per cent expenditure on the non-salary items (excluding relief, works proper for maintenance and election

contained in the non-plan budget of 1988-90. It is, therefore, requested that the details of units, sub-units etc. from which the reductions are to be made may be worked out and the savings surrendered. Necessary surrender statements may reach Finance Department by 31st December 1989.

A statement indicating departmentwise provisions for non-salary items (excluding relief, works proper for maintenance and election) in the non-Plan Budget of 1989-90 and the amount of reduction of expenditure expected from each Department is enclosed to this letter for your reference.

No. 2751—XVI-Aud-8/84.F.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 11 of the Orissa Local Fund Audit Act, 1948 (Orissa Act 5 of 1948), the State Government do hereby appoint the following authorities before whom appeals may be preferred under the said sub-section against the orders of surcharge or charge passed for amounts indicated against each in respect of audit reports relating to aided educational institutions, namely:—

1. Deputy Examiner of Local Accounts .. Against surcharge or charge orders for any amount passed by the District Audit Officers and Assistant Examiners of Local Accounts.
2. Examiner of Local Accounts .. Against surcharge or charge orders for any amount passed by the Deputy Examiner of Local Accounts.
3. Development Commissioner .. Against surcharge or charge orders for any amount passed by the Examiner of Local Accounts.
