RESOLUTION

Bhubaneswar, the 7/14 December, 1984.

Subject :- Surrender of Earned Leave in lieu of leave salary and allowances-Clarification regarding.

1. Before 7th June, 1982 the benefit of surrender leave was not admissible to a State Government servant who could not avail of the benefit during any past block period due to delay on the part of the sanctioning authority. On consideration of the hardship caused on this account, instructions have been issued in para-3 of Finance Department Resolution No.27181/F., dated 7th June, 1982 to the effect that where an eligible employee could not get the benefit of surrender leave due to only administrative delays, he may be allowed the benefit for the expired block period within the course of 3 months of the commencement of the subsequent block period. The authority sanctioning surrender leave in such cases are required to record reasons for delay in the sanction order.

2. In spite of allowing time for 3 months for sanctioning the benefit of surrender leave in the cases mentioned above, it has come to the notice that in some cases it has not been possible to take decision within the course of 3 months. In consideration of the above facts, Government in modification of decision contained in para-3 of Finance Department Resolution No.27181/F., dated 7th June, 1982 have been pleased to decide that where the benefit of surrender leave could not be granted due to administrative delays such benefit for past block period may be allowed within the course of 6 months from the date of commencement of subsequent block period subject to the condition that reasons for delay should be recorded in the sanction order. No further extension of time regarding grant of benefit of surrender leave for the past block will, however, be admissible.

3. The above decision will come into force from the date of issue of the Resolution.

ORDER :- Ordered that the Resolution be published in the next issue of the Orissa Gazette for general information and copies of the Resolution be forwarded to all concerned.
