Subject:-

Limit of leave preparatory to retirement.

The undersigned is directed to invite a

reference to Rule 7(2) of the Orissa Leave Rules, 1966 and Rule 157

of the Orissa Service Code, in which maximum Earned Leave that may

be granted at a time to a Government servant has been restricted to

120 days. On this basis leave preparatory to retirement was also

limited to 120 days. In the mean time Government have decided, vide

Finance Department Office Memorandum No. CS-II-54/77-60319/F. dated

18th November, 1977, that accumulated Earned Leave upto a maximum

period of 180 days can be encashed by a Government servant

proceeding on retirement on superannuation. Governor has therefore

been pleased to decide that earned leave preparatory to retirement

can be availed of by a Government servant subject to a maximum of

180 days instead of 120 days as at present.

Requisite amendments to the Orissa Leave Rules,

1966 and the Orissa Service Code will follow.
