

Sub:-

Admissibility of joining time on return from study leave.

The undersigned is directed to say that according to Rule, 198(b) of the Orissa Service Code, joining time is normally admissible on return from leave of not more than 6 months duration. It has, however, come to the notice of the Finance Department that in a number of cases, proposals are received for extension of joining time in respect of Officers availing study leave on the ground that it could not be possible to finalise their posting before expiry of study leave sanctioned to them. Such proposals lead to unnecessary additional expenditure as the Officers are being paid without performing duties, though joining time is normally not admissible in such cases.

2. In order to avoid the problem regarding sanction/extension of joining time leading to extra expenditure, it is requested that suitable instructions may be issued to the Officers availing study leave to intimate well in advance to the concerned authorities about the possible dates of their joining on expiry of study leave so that action for their posting could be initiated in time and there would be no occasion to keep the Officers waiting for a posting. On the otherhand, on receipt of advance intimation by the concerned authorities, they should ensure that suitable posting orders are issued before the dates of expiry of the study leave of the Officers so that they can join their new places of posting without availing joining time.
