Bhubaneswar, the 18th February 1989

Subject—Rounding off of transactions in Government accounts under the salary savings scheme.

With a view to simplifying the accounting procedure and ensuring smooth management of payment and receipts it has been decided by Government in Finance Department O. M. No. 56393-F., dated the 22nd January 1986 and O. M. No. 1048-F., dated the 12th January 1989 that all Government transactions involving fraction of a rupee shall be brought into accounts by rounding off to the nearest rupee.

In the case of cash transactions for L. I. C. Premium and deduction of 1/8

per cent of the premium towards Government commission the accounting procedure to be followed is set out below :—

- (1) Individual premium of each employee under the salary savings scheme shall be deducted by rounding off to the nearest rupee while preparing the salary bills and the Invoices meant for the L. I. C. of India. In the process, fractions of 50 paise and above may be rounded off to the next higher rupee and fractions of less than 50 paise be ignored.
- (2) The 1/8th percentum of the premium towards Government Commission deducted by the Treasuries shall be similarly rounded off to the nearest rupee before making payment to the L. I. C. Authorities.
