

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 213 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance in the Forty-sixth Year of the Republic of India:—

Short title  
and commencement.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Orissa Sales Tax (Amendment) Ordinance, 1995.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 27th day of May 1995

2. In Section 3 of the Orissa Sales Tax Act, 1947 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act) in clause (a) of sub-section (2-e), the words and commas "including surcharge, if any," wherever they occur shall be omitted.
