OFFICE MEMORANDUM

No. PF.8/55-9709/F., Dated the 12th April, 1955

The undersigned is directed to invite a reference to this Department Memorandum No. 15405/F., dt. the 21st July, 1954 permitting the grant of advance from General Provident Fund for house-building purposes to Government servants nearing the age of retirement. It has now been felt that the repayment of the advance causes considerable hardship to the persons concerned at a stage of their career when their commitments are very heavy. Moreover, the amounts at their credit in the General Provident Fund would become payable to them in any case within the next few years. In view of the difficulties pointed out above Government have carefully considered the question and have been pleased to direct that final withdrawals from the General Provident Fund may be permitted to Government servants for house building purposes subject to the terms and conditions contained in this Department office memorandum referred to above.

In the case of Government servants who have already draw repayable advances from General Provident Fund for house-building purpose under the orders contained in this Department memorandum No. 15405/F., dated the 21st July, 1954, the outstanding amount (with interest) of the repayable advance may at the written request of the Government servant concerned, be sanctioned as a final withdrawal from his General Provident Fund.

3. Advances granted previously under this Department office Memorandum dated the 21st July, 1954 will, however, continue to be regulated thereunder, unless the advances are converted into non-repayable withdrawals under para 2 of this office Memorandum.
